EDITORIAL

A letter from member Woodbury reads in part: "I have done a considerable work with the listing you sent. First I made a card for each town to start a filing system. I have "spotted" each town that is on my Czech map—my big one on my desk. Thus I have something I always wanted. Part of the Munich agreement had to do with a list or a map of the districts to be taken over in four invasions. But I have never been able to get anything except the text of the agreement which never seems to have the map or listing with it. Now I have it and by use of slides I think I can get something of interest for a lecture to go with my collection which is really getting to be quite extensive.

Now, if you consider publishing this material I now have: I think it should be printed on the four middle pages of the Specialist in each issue where it appears, even if there are several months between releases. If you devote these four pages to several such projects but alternate the months on which they appear, more people get something they want over a given period, and by assembling these center four pages the information can be filed in a booklet at one place at the end instead of here and there through the file of the Specialists. This would encourage more \$5 and \$10 memberships. The regular file can be kept and the duplicate set can be rearranged to make these booklets. Why not give the idea a good write up in the editorial for reaction. The next best thing to more members is more associate and patron members; they are real BUGS and will stay with us longer.

Would you be interested in the map of the Second Republic like I have on my desk but reproduced in black and white; reading town names on this is good. I have the master sheet (negative) made full size so that I can furnish copies of it at a reasonable price but hesitate to offer it for sale. I suppose I might offer a few copies of Hradčany stamps for \$1.50 and give a map as a present with it. Like beating the ceiling by running up the price a tractor brings by giving a bale of hay as part of the deal. The map is about 30x40 on good strong paper, white with black words. Excellent for research work."

Why should we go to the trouble of giving a write up when Ken does it so well? We're interested in members' reactions. Write us.

From member Trnovsky we received two parcels of back issues of Czech philatelic magazines. Some of these have been missing from our files and we thank him for his kindness. It is our desire at a later day to offer the duplicates to members for the price of the postage (if we ever get to it).

From member Rosner's column in the Sunday edition of the Czech daily SVORNOST we learn of member Cifka who after the death of Mr. Pade (the "mixture man") was Mrs. Pade's chief associate and who won for himself an enviable place in Denver and its environs. We quote: "As for Tony, a Canadian educated in the U. S. A. and in Czechoslovakia and himself a distinguished Czechoslovakian specialist, he and Royal Warren have now opened a ground-floor shop bearing the name Old West Stamp Shop, at 1827 Glenarm Place, Denver, Colo., right in the heart of things. Their stock includes just about everything in stamps and full lines of albums and accessories. Best of luck to them in the new venture." We add our congratulations to Tony and his partner.

The greatest news to reach collectors of Czechoslovakia is the announcement in this issue of the Specialist of the release of album pages for the stamps of Czechoslovakia from 1945 to 1953. When the publisher brought to the editor the first copy he asked us to assure purchasers that if they receive smudged or creased copies or if any pages are missing, these would be replaced when the next supplement appears. George tells us he is experimenting with cuts for the future issues of his albums. We are certain that buyers of this album will be more than pleased not only with the layout but especially with the fine quality of the paper used. Your editor is proud of his modest contribution to this venture and sincerely hope this initial effort meets with success.

This space could have been devoted to something of philatelic importance; you rob yourself of philatelic food which should be served through these pages and you also rob those who already have paid their dues. THE SECOND REPUBLIC STAMP ALBUM

In the January Specialist we mentioned that George Kobyłka is preparing album pages for Czechoslovakia 1945-53. We are now happy to announce that George's dream has become a reality. A handy and inexpensive standard three ring binder can hold all the pages for the postage stamps of the country exclusive of the various service stamps. It is mildly specialized; by that we mean it contains space for the various tabs, for the plate numbers where they appear and gutter pairs. Those who add position blocks to their collection can purchase additional pages labeled "Four Corner Positions"; col-

lectors of FDCs can obtain pages labeled "First Day Covers" and still others who specialize more thoroughly can buy plain pages with only a plain line border with the country's name CZECHOSLOVAKIA in the upper right corner.

Each issue is well written up telling the technical story of the stamps. To give the reader an idea of what the album contains we reprint the information on page one:

"KOSICE ISSUE

Printed in Kosice and produced by the offset process on white, unwatermarked paper. The first three values were issued unperforated; the remaining values rouletted 12½. The stamps portraying Red Army soldier were printed in sheets of 400 stamps (2x100 and 2x20) with horizontal gutters between the 100 and 20 subject portions of the sheet and with vertical gutter between the 100 and 100 and between the 20 and 20 subject portions. Thus it is possible to have pairs with vertical and horizontal gutters as also blocks with cross gutters. The horizontal stamps showing clasped hands and symbolizing brotherhood of Slavic Nations were printed in sheets of 120 subjects. Plate numbers appear in the lower left corner of the sheet except on the 2K where plate number appears in both right and left corners. Of these stamps the soldier type was first issued March 26th and the clasped hand type was issued May 9th, 1945 in Kosice and after the complete liberation were in use throughout the Republic until they were demonetized January 31, 1946, in Bohemia, Moravia and Silesia and February 28, 1946, in Slovakia.

Quantity issued: 369,120 sets"

In appropriate boxes we find space for the seven stamps of this issue. Page 1A contains space for the horizontal gutters; 1B for the vertical gutters; 1C, 1D and 1E for the cross gutters and 1F for the plate numbers. Page 2 is devoted to the Kosice sheet and 2A for the broken leg variety of the 5K lion in the sheet. In this manner every value is treated with a pleasing mild specialization. When the present government decided to drop the ornamental tabs and plate numbers even mild specialization came to a stop and only the technical information appears with every issue.

We are certain this album will be a big hit and if our prediction is correct this is only the beginning of an entirely complete album for the country from 1918 to 1939; of the Protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia and of the puppet state of Slovakia; of the air mail, postage due, newspaper, and other service issues as also of a continuation of supplements which will keep the album up-to-date.

The paper employed in this album is a heavy offset stock and very serviceable. We recommend it to all who collect Czechoslovakia because it is the album everyone awaited a long time. Commemorative Postage Stamps L. N. Tolstoy

To commemorate the 125th Birthday Anniversary of Leo Nikolayevitch

Tolstoy (1828-1910) the Ministry of Communications issued on December 29, 1953, two commemorative postage stamps

Kčs 0.60, green, Kčs 1.00, brown,

showing the Tolstoy portrait designed by Jiří Horník, engraved by Jan Mráček. The stamps are recess-printed in sheets of 50 copies, of vertical format, dimension of the picture 23x30 mm. Cadre perforation 12½:12¼. The printing was done by the Post Printing Office in Praha. Validity for postage from 29th December, 1953.

An official First Day Cover designed and engraved by Jiří Švengsbír was also issued.



Special issue to mark Transportation

The Ministry of Communications issued on 29th December, 1953, two postage stamps to propagate the Air and Railway Transportation,

Kčs 0.60, dark blue, Kčs 1.00, light blue.

The Kčs 0.60 stamp shows a locomotive and the inscription in Czech: "The Socialist Labor Competition and the Soviet Methods of Labor improve the Railway Transportation." This stamp is the expression of solidarity of Czechoslovak and Soviet railwaymen. The design is by František Postránecký.

The Kčs 1.00 stamp shows an aeroplane loading mail for air transport. The text on this stamp remembers the 30 years of air mail transport by the Czechoslovak Air Lines. The design is by Albert Jonáš, architect.

The stamps were printed in the Post Printing Office in Prague in sheets of 50 copies. Horizontal format, size of the picture 40x23 mm, frame perforation 11¼:11¼.

It is the first combined printing of the Czechoslovak stamps where the picture was printed in photogravure and the frame in recess-print.

Validity for postage from 29th December, 1953.

An official First Day Cover was designed by František Postránecký and engraved by Jan Mráček.

Future Issues

January 21st, a series to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the death of V. I. Lenin, comprising 2 values of Kčs 0.30, portraying V. I. Lenin, and Kčs 1.40, showing the museum of V. I. Lenin in Prague. (Total face \$0.235)

February 18th, a series to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the Fifth Congress of the Czechoslovak Communist Party (18.2.-23.2.1929), consisting of two values of Kčs 0.60 and 2.40 (Total face US \$0.415)

February 20th, a series of current stamps with different motives, comprising five values of Kčs 0.20, 0.45, 1.00, 1.60 and 2.00 (Total face \$0.73)

During March, a series commemorating the death of J. V. Stalin and Kl. Gottwald, comprising three values of Kčs 0.30, 0.60 and 1.20 (Total face US \$0.30).

First day covers will also be issued for each of the aforesaid commemorative series.
