## EDITORIAL

As we begin another volume of our beloved Specialist we feel proud of the success we had with this publication. The cooperation of many members, the vocal appreciation of our efforts from many more, make a difficult task much easier. The Society has a fine tradition behind it. Ever since the first issue of this publication it was the desire of its editors to present to the readers information both new and old. It was always our wish to give true studies of the stamps of Czechoslovakia. If we were proved wrong we made a public admission of our error and presented the correction.

We have been sent a unique item by our friend Alfons Stach. Unable to find someone in a hurry to photograph this fine block, hesitating to send it to a commercial photographer (they have ruined several of our stamps and lost a valuable portrait), we have hopes of showing a reproduction in the next issue of this paper.

Sometimes we get gripes from members which are truly legitimate. One member writes: "I complained about the way some members handle the circuits. 1). Very poor hinging. I had to reHINGE about 50 stamps in the last circuit. The least bit of moisture applied to a hinge gives more tension than taking off all the gum from the hinge. 2). Hinges are not expensive. By cutting a stamp hinge in half you really save nothing and may injure a good stamp. 3). All of us are stamp collectors. Why not use stamps of philatelic value when forwarding the circuit instead of meter stickers? The cost to you is the same, yet you can gladden the heart of a collector by using commemorative stamps or odd value prexies in good condition."

The same member has already sent a donation to the stamp auction we will hold even if we are unable to hold a stamp exhibition this season. We thank this member very cordially.

Another unusual ad appears in our organ this month. In a way we are glad of it. We have been taking daily therapeutic treatments, this cut our "free time" about 15 hours each week. We haven't taken a day off from work since the middle of November and every citizen knows that a post office employee's chance of staying home in December is almost nil. Another good reason for accepting a 5 page ad is the condition of the treasury toward the end of the year. Most of our articles need many illustrations and these are very costly. If our treasury can bear the burden of 11 issues, 16 pages each, in 1955, we shall endeavor to make up to you the loss of reading matter with interest.

Some time in April we hope to have a special issue of the National Phila-

telic magazine STAMPS. If you have worthwhile information on some phase of Czecho philately, don't keep it to yourself but send it to the editor. If not overly specialized it will appear in STAMPS and later will be reprinted in your Specialist. Perpetuate your name in philately.

Kindly pay your 1955 dues as soon as possible. We should like to budget ourselves for the year. The money we saved during the war years when paper was unobtainable is already gone and we are leading a hand to mouth existence.

To all members and their families the officers of the Society wish a Happy and truly Philatelic New Year.

### PARADE OF NEW ISSUES

#### New Commemoratives "The Month of the Czechoslovak-Soviet Freindship 1954"



The month of the Czechoslovak-Soviet Friendship 1954 was remembered by Ministry of Communications by the issue of three commemorative postage stamps of the following motives, denominations and colors:

1. Transmitting experiences from the Soviet agriculture,  
30 hal. value, light brown.
2. Transmitting experiences from the Soviet industry,  
60 hal. value, blue.
3. Culture collaboration with the Soviet Union,  
2 Kčs value, brick red.

The author of all three motives is Václav Fiala, graphic artist.

The first stamp was engraved by Bohdan Roule, the second by Jaroslav Goldschmied and the third by Jindra Schmidt.

All the stamps were recess-printed in the Post Printing Office in Prague in sheets of 50 copies of horizontal form, 40 x 23 in dimension.

Validity for postage from November 6th, 1954.

The official First Day cover was designed by Václav, Fiala, engraved by Ladislav Jirka.

#### New Commemoratives "Poets"



On the occasion of the anniversaries of the poets Jan Neruda, born 10.7.1834, Janko Jesenský, born 30.12.1874, and Jiří Wolker, died on 3.1.1924, the Ministry of Communications issued three commemorative postage stamps with the poets' portraits.

The designs, values and colors are as follows:

1. Jan Neruda, 30 hal., blue. The author of the design is Karel Štika, the engraving is done by Jindra Schmidt.
2. Janko Jesenský, 60 hal., red. Design by Prof. Karel Štika; engraving by Jaroslav Goldschmied.
3. Jiří Wolker, 1.60 Kčs value, violet brown. Designed by Arno Neuman; graphic artist; engraved by Ladislav Jirka.

All the three stamps were recess-printed by the Post Printing Office in Prague in sheets of 50 copies. Dimension of the pictures 23 x 30 mm.

Validity for postage from November 25, 1954.

The official First Day Cover was designed by Professor Karel Štika; engraved by Jaroslav Goldschmied.

#### New Postage Due Stamps (First Part)



On November 22nd, 1954, the Ministry of Communications issued new Postage Due Stamps (First Part) comprising four values

30 hal., green	95 hal., green
1.00 Kčs, violet	1.50 Kčs, violet

The design and the engraving of the 30 and 95 hal. values are by Bohdan Roule. The 1.00 Kčs values were designed and engraved by J. A. Švengsbír.

All the stamps were recess-printed in double sheets of 200 copies. The stamps designed by Bohdan Roule are of horizontal form 21 x 17.5 mm. in dimension; the stamps by Švengsbír are of vertical form 17.5 x 21 mm.

The new Postage Dues are valid only inland from November 22, 1954. For the time being the existing Postage Dues remain provisionally valid.
